**Carol Whitmore** was elected Junior Vice Commander-in-Chief of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the U.S. on July 27, 2023, at the 124th VFW National Convention in Phoenix, Arizona.

Carol served in the U.S. Army from 1977 to 2013, earning her VFW eligibility by serving in Iraq. In recognition of her service, she received the Legion of Merit Medal, Bronze Star Medal, Army Commendation Medal (six), Army Achievement Medal, Good Conduct Medal, among many others. <u>Read her full official</u> <u>biography</u>. **She joined the VFW in 2012 at Post 9127 (Beaverdale)** in Des Moines, Iowa, where she maintains her Gold Legacy Life membership.

In 2022, she was elected as designee for National VFW Commander-in-Chief for the year 2025, becoming the first woman and first Iowan to hold the position. She has served in elected and appointed positions at the Post, District and Department levels, culminating with her election as the VFW Department of Iowa Commander from 2018 to 2019, in which she achieved All American status. On the national level, she served on the Legislative Committee, the General Resolutions Committee, and on the National Council of Administration from 2019 to 2023. Carol attended the University of Northern Iowa and Hawkeye Community College, where she received her nursing certification. She is retired. She is a life member of the Military Order of the Cootie, the VFW National Home, the American Legion and its Auxiliary, and a member of the Iowa Veterans Commission. Carol and her husband, Brad, reside in Des Moines, Iowa.



The Purple Heart is a United States military decoration awarded in the name of the President to those wounded or killed while serving, on or after 5 April 1917, with the U.S. military. The Purple Heart, the first U.S. military decoration, instituted by General George Washington in 1782 and awarded for bravery in action. The Purple Heart is the oldest military award still given to U.S. military members.

# Navajo Code Talkers Day

Navajo Code Talkers Day, is celebrated every year on August 14. This is a day that holds great importance in the history of the U.S.



This is because the day recognizes the contributions of Navajo marines during World War II.

## August 14, 2023

Navajo marines encoded and transmitted messages using a complex Navajo language-based code during a time when secret communication was essential to win a war. The code was never broken by Japanese forces in the Pacific and proved to be of great assistance to the U.S. Marines. On this day, celebrate the great American heroes and their service to the nation.



It all started in 1942 when the U.S. was fighting World War II in the Pacific and needed an unbreakable code to ensure the success of military operations. During this time, Philip Johnston, the son of a missionary who had grown up in the Navajo Nation, suggested using the Navajo language as a code. After this, there was no turning back and the U.S. government recruited over 400 Navajo men to serve during the war. The Navajo Code Talkers successfully transmitted more than 800 messages without error and helped the U.S. win the war.
