





On Veterans Day 2024, we plan to have the same locations set up as we had for this Memorial Day. However, we need to have our volunteers planning far enough ahead that we can put one to two persons in each shift.







D-Day: June 6th, 1944, is etched in history as D-Day, the day Allied forces launched a massive invasion of Nazioccupied Normandy, France, during World War II. Codenamed Operation Overlord, this pivotal military campaign involved over 156,000 troops from the United States, Britain, Canada, and other Allied nations.

The operation began with a perilous amphibious assault on five beachheads—Utah, Omaha, Gold, Juno, and Sword—supported by extensive air and naval bombardments. Despite facing fierce resistance and heavy casualties, the successful landings marked the beginning of the end for Nazi Germany, leading to the liberation of Western Europe and ultimately contributing to the Allied victory in the war.



Flag Day (US): Flag Day in the United States is observed on June 14th, commemorating the adoption of the Stars and Stripes as the nation's official flag by the Second Continental Congress in 1777.

The resolution defined the flag's design, specifying 13 stripes and

13 stars to represent the original colonies. President Woodrow Wilson officially established June 14th as Flag Day in 1916, and later, in 1949, Congress designated it as a national day of observance.

Father's Day is celebrated on the third Sunday in June. The holiday was first proposed in 1909 by Sonora Smart Dodd, who wanted to honor her father, a Civil War veteran and single parent who raised six children.

The summer solstice occurs in June, which is the day with the longest daylight hours and the shortest night of the year. It usually falls on June 20th or 21st.
