September is known for a number of days and events. Probably the most known event that comes to mind for most of us is Labor Day.

Americans in the late 1800s worked 12-hour days for a basic living, (\$16 \$19.00 a week), and children worked in mills, factories and mines, earning far less (\$5 to \$9.00 a week) than adults. During this period, labor unions increased their efforts to call for better working conditions, and pay. The first recorded Labor Day celebration took place in 1882 in New York. It became a national holiday in 1894 under then President Grover Cleveland. The holiday was to be observed on the first Monday in September annually, according to the U.S. Department of Labor.

FORGET

Since it is a Federal Holiday, state, local and federal offices will be closed on Labor Day. Schools, banks and the post office will also be closed for the holiday.

Labor Day as we know it now is to honor workers and recognize their contributions to society.



The holiday observed in the United States on September 11 to commemorate the lives of those who died in the 2001 terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center in New York City and the Pentagon in Virginia and those who perished when the hijacked United Air lines Flight 93 crashed in Pennsylvania. The holiday also recognizes those

who died attempting to rescue people trapped by the attacks. It is by Congressional proclamation that all U.S. flags be flown at half-staff. Further, Americans are asked to honor the dead with a moment of silence beginning at 8:46 AM, Eastern Standard Time, the time that the first airplane struck the World Trade Center, and to respect the ceremonies of remembrance when they are conducted.

#### Some other interesting items:

September is known for the start of the harvest months and the fall equinox, and traditionally the beginning of a new school year.
