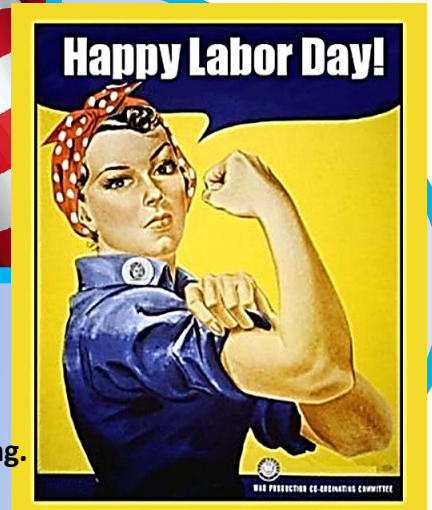

On August 12th Post 9668 took the ice cream concession trailer to the Adel Sweet Corn Fest for a one-day event which we have done for the last 12 years. This year was a little different in that the City of Adel did not furnish any electrical power to any of the street concessions. Everyone had to supply their own power by bringing a generator. In our case, our ice cream machine requires a 220 volt power source and the trailer appliances require a 4000 + watt, 110 volts source. We were up and running for about 45 minutes when the ice cream machine shut down. We restarted it and

after a few minutes it shut down again. This cycle kept repeating itself with no apparent reason for this to be happening. Our troubleshooting with a multimeter indicated everything in the trailer was operating normally. It was finally determined that our rented 220 & 110-volt, 6500 watt generator was only putting out a little over 150 volts of power. As a result, our ice cream machine kept shutting down in a safety mode to protect the compressor. So, for the rest of the day we had to keep turning the machine back on about every 5 to 10 minutes. Frustration to the highest degree! Also, try to imagine a hundred or more generators operating within a city square block. So noisy that you could not talk without raising your voice to be heard. And the exhaust fumes on a hot, humid day with little to no air movement kept the fumes from rising. We were so glad to see the 4:00 p.m. shut down time come. We expect the City of Adel will receive a number of complaints from the crafters and concessioners about this situation. We will be sending our own complaint, and rethinking our participation here.

By a joint resolution approved December 18, 2001, (Public Law 107-89), Congress authorized the president to designate September 11 of each year as "Patriot Day" to perpetuate the memory of those who perished in the attack on America.
